Performing Arts update

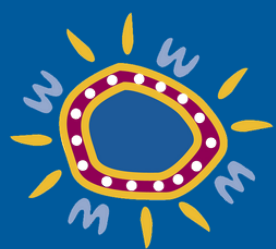
